Mandatory E-Invoicing Accelerates Across Europe: International Experts to Meet in Berlin

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Mandatory e-invoicing is rapidly becoming the global standard for VAT compliance, reshaping how businesses handle invoicing, tax reporting, and financial processes. As governments roll out new compliance frameworks – from Continuous Transaction Controls (CTCs) to Peppol-based reporting – many organisations are struggling to keep their systems and processes aligned with an increasingly complex regulatory landscape.

"Ten years ago, e-invoicing was discussed primarily as a way to improve efficiency. Today, it has become a strategic element of tax compliance and digital government policy. The debate has moved beyond whether companies need e-invoicing – the real challenge is how multinational organisations can keep pace with an increasingly fragmented regulatory landscape," says Johannes von Mulert, Chairman of the E-Invoicing Exchange Summit.
